Subject: Communistic propaganda in Ecuador.

As of possible interest to you, there is being transmitted herewith a memorandum containing a sample of the type of propaganda being circulated in Ecuador by the Fourth International. The memorandum is a verbatim translation of a mimeographed circular which has been introduced into Ecuador allegedly by either the German Legation or the Spanish Legation.

This information is also being furnished the Coordinator of Inter-American Affairs and the Coordinator of Information.

COMMUNISTIC PROPAGANDA IN ECUADOR

"The actual position of the Fourth International on the question of policy with the belligrent countries is as follows:

- 1. War between two imperialistic countries: Defeat by revolution.
- 2. War by an imperalistic country against a colonial or semicolonial country: Defeat in the imperialistic country and defense of the clonial or semi-colonial country.
- 3. War between twocolonial or semi-colonial countries. Revolutionary defeat y the Soviet Union.
- 4. War against any country: Defense in the Soviet Union by active defects in the nemy country.
- 5. War by the USSI and an imperialistic country on one side against imperialistic ountries or semi-colonials on the other side.

 Defeat of all scept the USSR. Soviet troops to occupy all the territories of the defeated nations.
- 6. In the case whre a semi-colonial nation has fallen under the influence of a imperial nation which results in the former being merely atool of the latter we will defeat and occupy them both.

"Since the oubreal of the Second World War sudden military and political change has been the order of the day. This has occurred principally in the weak and backwar nations. As a consequence of the war successes the situation in thosecountries and their relations with the belligerent countries is able to chage in a relatively short time, and from one day to the other. The political situation in the backward countries will lead them in the direction of loss of their independence, or military occupation, or extension or intenfication of the existing imperialistic domination. There is another bossibility: The master imperialist (Uncle Sam) may by necessity, under essure of events, have to concede greater independence to a country. E naturally such concessions will be very incomplete.

"The sections of theourth International must:

- Study intensively the conomic, social, and political situations in all those countrie not only from the static point of view, but also considering e relation of the actual forces and their possible evolution fr the dynamic point of view.
- Closely follow and spially analyze all military or political change which occur as consequence of the war events in those countries.

3. Adapt your politics to the new situation.

"The Spanish American Republics being backward nations are under the domination and contrd of the United States of North America and are semi-colonial subjects of the imperialistic Yankee. Therefore the USSR is not going to defend them in case of an attack which is imminent by Germany or Japan. We must therebre fight against the influence and control of the United States of the reak governments in these countries. The United States will transform thee Spanish American countries into colonial possessions. Only a communitic revolution will save their true independence and liberation from the aperialistic Yankee. The same in Ethiopia and China."

In regard to the bove propaganda, although there is no indication that the Communist Partyis allied with the Axis, nevertheless, all their efforts in this respect re being directed against the United States. They have likewise takenadvantage of the recent arrivals of the United States armed forces in Euador and the Gallapagos Islands by spreading propaganda to the effect that once they are located they will never leave, and Ecuador will become a puppet of the United States."
